## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 Background to the 'ECS' Global Online Conference

At the start of 2020, Kingdom Equip Network (K.E.N.) initiated the 'Equipping the Church Series' (ECS) aimed at offering training and advisory services to churches within a given community. Along the way, the world came under the nouvelle Covid-19 pandemic which affected churches with its consequent constraints. With this in mind, together with the Board and Partners, K.E.N. organized the Global Online Conference under the 'ECS' for church leaders and workers aimed at enlightening and supporting the efforts of churches for an ongoing effective church management.

The Conference was to bring together about 300 audience and 8 expert speakers from Africa, Europe and North America. The conference programme was framed around two thematic sessions:

- **Sub-Theme (I): 'Strategies for a Healthy Church'** - focusing on the church as an institution; defining the 'strategies for the healthy church'.

and;

- **Sub-Theme (II): "Physician, Heal thyself"** (*Personal Pastoral Care*) - focusing on the health of the leader which translates to the leader positioning himself/herself in God to effectively administer the health of the church.

### 1.2 Objectives of the Conference

The main objectives of the Conference among others was:

- To acquaint participants with the key indicators of a healthy church;
- To guide participants in identifying the steps towards a healthy personal spiritual life;
- To equip participants to translate their personal spiritual care into a healthy church life;
- To engage and enlighten participants on practical steps to build a healthy church;
- To lay the foundation for a continuous global dialogue on the issue of church health;
- To empower the capacity of Churches to withstand unexpected events such as the current Covid-19.

### 1.3 Organization of the Conference

The Conference was scheduled online on the 'Zoom Platform- Webinar'. Invitations were broadcast via emails, text messaging, phone calls, WhatsApp, Facebook, the K.E.N. Website and other social media links. General information on the Conference was also broadcast to registrants ahead of the Conference. By the Conference day- 27th August 2020, 269 people had registered.

A program outline was drawn having a moderator, other facilitators and 8 speakers from across the world. The speakers were divided under the two Conference sub-themes with four speakers for each session i.e. 1 speaker giving the main presentation supported by three speakers touching on their practical experience as it relates to the sub-theme (*See Appendix 1 below for Speaker details*). There was a time for questions from the audience, answered by the panel of speakers under each session/sub-theme.

In all, the Conference was successfully organized with 309 ‘users’ and 119 ‘Active participants’ (See Appendix 5 below for details). At the end of the Conference, participants sent in positive feedback<sup>1</sup>; a sample of which include:

## 2.0 SUMMARY | SUB-THEME (I): ‘STRATEGIES FOR A HEALTHY CHURCH’

- The main responsibility of the church is outlined in the Great Commission – Go and make disciples and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you (Matt 28:19-20).
- Pastors must provide leadership to accomplish this key mandate for a healthy church.
- Pastors must be healthy in their body, mind and be spiritually sound.
- The main mission of the church is evangelism and education of the flock.
- The church’s mission is the journey the church is on whilst the vision of the church is its destination.
- Effectively communicating the mission and the vision of the church to members would get them excited in partaking in it. If everyone understands it, they will follow.
- What the Covid-19 pandemic has shown the church is the need to reach out to non-Christians. There is the need to change the way we do church and outreach to our communities. The church in this era should not be seen as hiding behind church walls; they have to impact and be relevant in their communities.
- The church needs to be connected to the people it is trying to reach.
- There is the need for evangelism; to take the gospel and affect others by it through telephone calls, care and outreach to the community as well as the use of other practical means of communication including social media. It is also critical to work with small groups.
- Church leadership should be sacrificial (John 20:11). The Pastor must be available to the people and communicate his passion for the work to members.
- There is the need to get to know the situation of the people you are pastoring and be empathic in your approach.
- Encourage family involvement and encourage others to serve.
- With the pandemic, church face-to-face meeting can be limited to about two and other means of communication can also be utilized. Internet data support may be given to disadvantaged church members to get on the social media platforms.

### 3.0 SUMMARY | SUB-THEME (II): “PHYSICIAN, HEAL THYSELF”

- It is important for Pastors to lead themselves and provide wise leadership. Without wise leadership, the flock may scatter (Prov. 28:2, Matt 26:31).
- It is essential to understand the role of leadership; it is influence, not position.
- The leader is set apart to influence others to follow. Be fishers of men and convey the message of service (feet washing).
- The Pastor needs to grow his capacity and increase his impact on members. Influence comes through self-development, self-leadership and self-improvement; pressing toward the goal. (Phil 3:12).
- Growth comes from discipline. Invest in yourself, learn new skills set and run to win with purpose. Examine your life and the areas in which you need to improve. Challenge, confront, invest in and lead yourself to grow to greater heights.
- The pandemic has affected pastors and their congregation; it is essential for pastors to take care of themselves to be able to care for the congregation.
- It is essential to devise new ways to reach out to sick members.
- Create a conducive environment whilst adhering to the Covid-19 protocols in order to enable members to attend church.
- Speak the truth in love to those who are slacking and staying away/withdrawing from church.
- Win souls and reach out at all costs and by all means.
- Pastors have to demonstrate moral leadership and sincerity.
- Pastors must have healthy bodies, sound minds, be studious and have foundational knowledge. A healthy pastor will produce a healthy congregation.
- Know the work of a pastor and allow it to be relevant.
- Be prayerful (2 Tim 1:3); prayer is the key ingredient to keeping yourself and the church healthy. Stay on course and do the things God has called you to do. Pray and Fast.

### 4.0 SUMMARY | Q&A SESSION

- Can leadership succession affect the church?  
**ANS:** *It can affect the health of the church; the most important thing is good discipleship for the succeeding leaders.*
- How can we help the church to overcome complacency and Luke-warmness?  
**ANS:** *Covid-19 has allowed people to stay home however, leaders and pastors are to intercede for their members.*
- Influencing the community through community actions. How far can the church go without digressing?  
**ANS:** *It is important to keep your balance. It is important to always let people know that we belong to the church and we belong to Jesus.*

- If people are not cooperating to be carried along, what should be done?  
**ANS:** *You need to understand and appreciate why people are not going along. Maybe they do not understand the vision. Get to understand the underlying reason and tackle it.*
- Most ministries do not regard the growth of their workers. How do we curb this disillusion?  
**ANS:** *You need to get to know the people and give them an opportunity to grow because everyone desires to grow.*
- How do you work with leaders who do not believe in systems?  
**ANS:** *Systems saves you stress, time, energy and money. If any one does not believe in systems, he is not a leader.*
- How do you compel a reluctant member to be active?  
**ANS:** *You do not always need to take your concentration from the rest of the congregation for one member that is causing trouble. However, you should not give up on them but encourage them and pray for them.*
- How does one go about implementing a system that achieves the Mission?  
**ANS:** *Focus the church on evangelism and discipling people into greater maturity. Mature disciples become disciple-makers. Search YouTube for The Malphurs Group. We have videos posted covering all the topics I mentioned today.*
- What is your advice about many meetings, outside of Covid times? In other words, apart from Sunday church and another weekday meeting, there are other meetings such as choir, men women, prayer warriors, etc. one person could have as many as 4 or 5 meetings a week. How can it be streamlined?  
**ANS:** *Re-think what your church does and look for redundancies that could be combined with another ministry or discontinued. Strategize your ministries to accomplish the discipleship outcomes you desire. Don't just continue doing things because they've just always been done.*
- If all your effort to make this people to be committed fails what should I do?  
**ANS:** *You cannot "make" people be committed. You must lead by example, show them what God desires of them, and give them opportunities to grow into maturity.*
- When you involve your family in ministry, and people are saying is a family church, what should I do?  
**ANS:** *Ask other people, outside of your family, to become leaders and participants in the church.*
- How can we best advance the Gospel to the children in this Covid season where they are not allowed to meet as a ministry?  
**ANS:** *Create children-specific content each week, either to be used live on Sunday mornings, or recorded and shared. I have seen churches do so.*

Kingdom Equip Network (K.E.N.) is a coalition of individuals and organizations who seek to use their spiritual and professional resources to enhance the governance of churches. 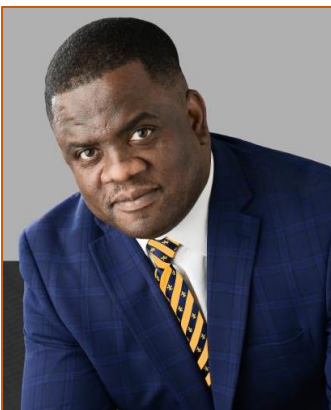
